Week 8 "Game of the Week" recap....

Well, the Bearkats did it! They snapped a **6-game winning streak against McNeese State** by defeating the Cowboys last Saturday, 38-14. Sophomore RB, Tim Flanders rushed for more than half of SHSU's total 246 yds on the ground (162 yds on 19 attempts) and 2 TD's. The Kats forced 3 fumbles and held McNeese to less than 2 yds of avg net gain rushing. A mixed bag of special teams and offensive scoring made the difference... 55 yd run, blocked punt return, and 41 yd pass plays made for a 21-0, 3rd quarter edge that sealed the deal for SHSU. Sam Houston State sits atop the Southland at 4-0, 7-0 overall.

Other head-to-head streaks (3 or more considered a streak) broken over the weekend include:

- Maine breaks 3-game streak against Richmond, 23-22
- Rhode Island breaks 4-game streak against Delaware, 38-34.
- Chattanooga breaks 5-game streak against Elon, 42-18
- Gardner-Webb breaks 7-game streak against Coastal Carolina, 26-24
- Towson breaks 7-game streak against William & Mary, 38-27
- Florida A&M breaks 8-game streak against SC State, 27-24
- Georgetown breaks 8-game streak against Colgate, 40-17
