

The 2012 FCS Football season is just weeks away. Here are a few things to get you caught up.

- There are now 122 teams (126 in 2011) in 13 conferences (15 in 2011) in FCS Football
- The Great West Conference is defunct and there are no Independents
- Teams that moved to FBS level are UT-San Antonio. Texas State. South Alabama, and UMass.
- Big Sky has the largest conference now at 13 teams (4 came over from the Great West)
- There are 14 new head coaches in 9 conferences.
- A 20 team post-season selection will continue in 2012....NCAA will likely increase to 24 teams in 2013.

The 2012 FCS Preseason polls are finalized for each conference. Here are the teams ranked #1 going into the upcoming season (coaches picks):

Big Sky- Montana State Bobcats Big South- Stony Brook Seawolves Colonial Athletic-Towson Tigers Ivy League- Harvard Crimson Ohio Valley- Eastern Kentucky Colonels Patriot League- Lehigh Mountain Hawks MEAC- Norfolk State Spartans Missouri Valley- North Dakota State Bison Northeast- Albany Great Danes Pioneer- San Diego Toreros Southern- Georgia Southern Eagles Southland- Sam Houston State Bearkats **SWAC- Grambling State Tigers**

- Lehigh is the only team from this group that was preseason #1 from 2011
- This is Norfolk State's first #1 preseason ranking in the MEAC
- Towson went from ranked last in 2011 preseason to first place in 2012
- Only 3 preseason #1 teams from 2011 went to the playoffs last year (N. Iowa, Lehigh, App State)

This year's NFL Draft was one of the most highly anticipated featuring big time FBS talent: Andrew Luck (#1 pick/Stanford), Robert Griffin III (Heisman winner/Baylor), Trent Richardson (2012 BCS Champion/Alabama), and many others.

12 FCS players were drafted by the NFL featuring App State's star WR, Brian Quick going 1st in the 2nd round to the St. Louis Rams.

89 FCS players were NFL undrafted free agents featuring William & Mary RB, Jonathan Grimes (Houston Texans) and 2008 FCS Champion, WR Tre Gray (Arizona Cardinals).

4 FCS players were drafted into the CFL including Christo Bilukidi who was drafted by the Winnipeg Blue Bombers and the Oakland Raiders of the NFL. Christo is the first player from Georgia State to be drafted into the NFL.
