The **Bethune-Cookman Wildcats** of the MEAC will battle the **Alabama State Hornets** of the SWAC at the 8th annual "MEAC/SWAC Challenge" sponsored by Disney. This game has the makings of being a classic as both teams are <u>ranked in the top 10 in HBCU football</u>. The game will be played at the Florida Citrus Bowl. Kickoff is 12pm ET on Sunday, 9/2/2012 and will be aired on ESPN.

#### Here are a few facts about the MEAC/SWAC Challenge:

- MEAC leads the head-to-head series 5-2
- Southern University is the only SWAC team to have won the Challenge
- The first 3 games were played in Birmingham, AL and last 4 games were played in Orlando, FL
- Out of the 7 games played, a SWAC team has only lead at halftime once

## Here's more on MEAC/SWAC:

- Before it was known as the "MEAC/SWAC Challenge", the annual postseason matchup between the two conferences was called The Heritage Bowl.
- The MEAC has a winning percentage of .537; the SWAC at .484
- Head-to-head, the SWAC leads the MEAC, 259-236 (with 13 ties)
- The SWAC has the most Hall of Famers at 42; MEAC has 30

#### **Mercer University**

Located in Macon, Georgia (main campus)

Mascot: Bears

Head coach: Bobby Lamb

- Mercer's last football game was played in 1941 (loss to Chattanooga, 40-13)
- Mercer won its first football game in the fall of 1892 against Georgia Tech in the Yellow Jackets' first-ever college football game, 12-6.
- Mercer will be joining the Pioneer conference





### Stetson University

Located in Deland, Florida Mascot: Hatters

Head coach: Roger Hughes

- Stetson has not had a football team since the 1956 season.
- Stetson was the first organized football team in the state of Florida (1894)
  - Stetson will be joining the Pioneer conference



Head coach: Brad Lambert

- UNCC first played a 5 game schedule in 1947, three of the teams were Appalachian State (Teachers College), Presbyterian, and Davidson.
- UNCC played it's final game in 1948
- The 49'ers will play 2013 & 2014 as an FCS independent FCS and will compete in its first FBS season in Conference USA in 2015. Charlotte will be bowl eligible for football in the 2016 season.
