- Youngstown State's win was the first of the Missouri Valley Conference defeating Pittsburgh.
- UT-Martin avenges a 27 point loss to Memphis in 2009 and shock the Tigers.

This inner-state matchup should be a battle. Norfolk State's coming off their 1st MEAC conference ring and 1st post-season appearance last year. Liberty is coming off a near-upset win last week against ACC opponent, Wake Forest. Norfolk ranked #2 in total defense in the FCS last week, allowing 107 total yds. Liberty outgained Wake Forest 363 to 293 in net yards- rushed for 91 yds, and passed for 272. Solid offense versus solid defense. First year head coach, Turner Gill and the Flames will host the Spartans at a 7pm ET kickoff.
