McNeese State 27, Middle Tennessee 21 Eastern Washington 20, Idaho 3 Youngstown State 31, Pittsburgh 17 UT- Martin 20, Memphis 17 North Dakota State 22, Colorado State 7 Ilinois State 31, Eastern Michigan 14 Sacramento State 30, Colorado 28 Northern Arizona 17, UNLV 14

- North Dakota State's third-consecutive victory over an FBS team (beat Kansas 6-3 in 2010; best Minnesota 37-24 in 2011)
- Illinois State's first win against an FBS opponent since 1991 (beat Akron 25-3)
- Sacramento State makes it 2-straight wins against the PAC-12 (beat Oregon State 29-28 in 2011)

- First time Northern Arizona has faced UNLV since 1992 and first win against the Mountain West

- Largest margin of victory: 82 pts -Wofford 82, Lincoln (PA) 0
- Shortest margin of victory: 3 games decided by 2 points
