#### FBS upset counter- 10:

- The **Stony Brook Seawolves** won their 1st contest against an FBS opponent last Saturday. Senior RB, Miguel Maysonet lead with 220 yds rushing on 32 carries and 2 TD's.
- Hats off to..... **Wofford's** Eric Breitenstein rushed for 321 yds on 27 carries and 2 TD's against Elon and lead the Terriers to a 49-24 win. That was a Southern Conference single-game rushing record...**SE Louisiana** has momentum- broke losing streak to McNeese State last week, now they edged Lamar on the road, 31-21 in their first win against the Cardinals since 1969... **Chattanooga** avenged a loss on the same weekend last year to a hot Citadel Bulldog squad winning 28-10 on the road...**Robert Morris** broke a 9 game losing streak and handed Lafayette their first loss of the season, 31-28...The Sycamores of **Indiana State** held Southern Illinois to 3 pts & put up 24 and snapped a 9-game skid to the Salukis...**Murray State** scored the most points ever against Tenn Tech and got their 3rd straight victory over the Golden Eagles, 70-35...**Alabama A&M** crushed Grambling 38-17 and went 5-0 for the first time since 1966 (8-0 start).
- Largest margin of victory: 50 pts - Eastern Illinois 65, Austin Peay 15
- Shortest margin of victory: 4 games decided by 3 points
- # of shut-outs: 1- SC State 14, Norfolk State 0
- Six OT games this season: None in week 5
- Game with highest attendance: Southern vs. Florida A&M - 41,042 (played in Georgia Dome)
